The Historic Built Environment of the Addison Region

Glenn Andres, Professor Emeritus, History of Art and Architecture, taught primarily in the areas of architectural and urban history, at Middlebury from 1970 through spring semester 2015. His research spans from the Italian Renaissance through 19th century America to post modernism. He holds a bachelor's degree in architecture from Cornell University and a Ph.D. in architectural history from Princeton University. His doctoral dissertation on the Villa Medici in Rome was pursued while a fellow of the American Academy in Rome.

He has published on Renaissance villas, the architecture of Florence, New England meeting houses, Vermont regional architecture, American modernism, and the work of Hardy Holzman Pfeiffer. His most recent work includes The Buildings of Vermont (with Curtis B. Johnson, Charlottesville, University of Virginia Press, 2014). He has served on the Middlebury Design Advisory Committee, the Vermont Advisory Committee for Historic Preservation, and as a trustee of the Sheldon Museum.
