### **7:30 p.m. Public Hearing:**

The Addison County Regional Planning Commission will hold the first of two public hearings on the proposed amendments to and re-adoption of the Addison County Regional Plan. The Addison County Regional Planning Commission proposes to make amendments to the following Sections of its Plan:

1. Section 1, Introduction;
2. Section 2, Substantial Regional Impact;
3. Section 2A, Implementation (new);
4. Section 8, Future Land Use

It also proposes to re-adopt the entire Plan as amended. Accordingly, all sections of the Plan will be subject to discussion at the public hearing. The panel will discuss potential impacts to local road construction and maintenance, stormwater systems, wastewater systems and tactical basin planning. They will also take questions from the audience regarding what the Clean Water Act and the Lake Champlain TMDL mean to them or their municipality.
